UNM University Archives Fellowship Center for Southwest Research and Special Collections The University of New Mexico

The UNM University Archives Fellowship is awarded to a graduate student enrolled at the University of New Mexico for work in the Center for Southwest Research and Special Collections (CSWR). The CSWR contains the University Archives for the University of New Mexico, which is responsible for identifying and preserving historically and legally significant records that document the University's three basic functions of teaching, research, and public service.

Duties and Responsibilities

The Fellow will appraise and arrange historical paper and electronic records related to the Charlie Morrissey Research Hall. These records come from the Program of Africana Studies. Once the records are organized and arranged, a finding aid will be completed and placed in the New Mexico Archives Online repository. Digitized materials may be uploaded into the UNM Digital Repository and corresponding metadata created.

Terms of the Award

The award is for \$16,000 and will be for Fall 2022 and Spring 2023. The Fellow will work 20 hours each week during the semester including finals week. University-wide holidays are excepted. Health insurance is provided with the assistantship.

Selection Criteria

Required:

- Graduate student in residence at the University of New Mexico with a minimum of 6 credit hours of course work, thesis or dissertation hours which count towards the graduate degree.
- Background in humanities or social sciences with a concentration in Southwestern history and culture
- Good communication, organization and time management skills

Legally authorized to work in the United States

Preferred:

- Knowledge of relevant software applications
- Knowledge of basic archival principles

Application Requirements

- Letter of application specifically addressing the selection criteria
- Two letters of recommendation from individuals familiar with applicant's academic and work experience; letters should include telephone numbers for verification
- Copy of a recent research paper (first 1-3 pages only)
- Applicant's resume/curriculum vitae
- Completed application form
